Welcome to Beaveree 2009. We hope that everyone is planning on attending. This year we will be using the Albion Hills Conservation Area.

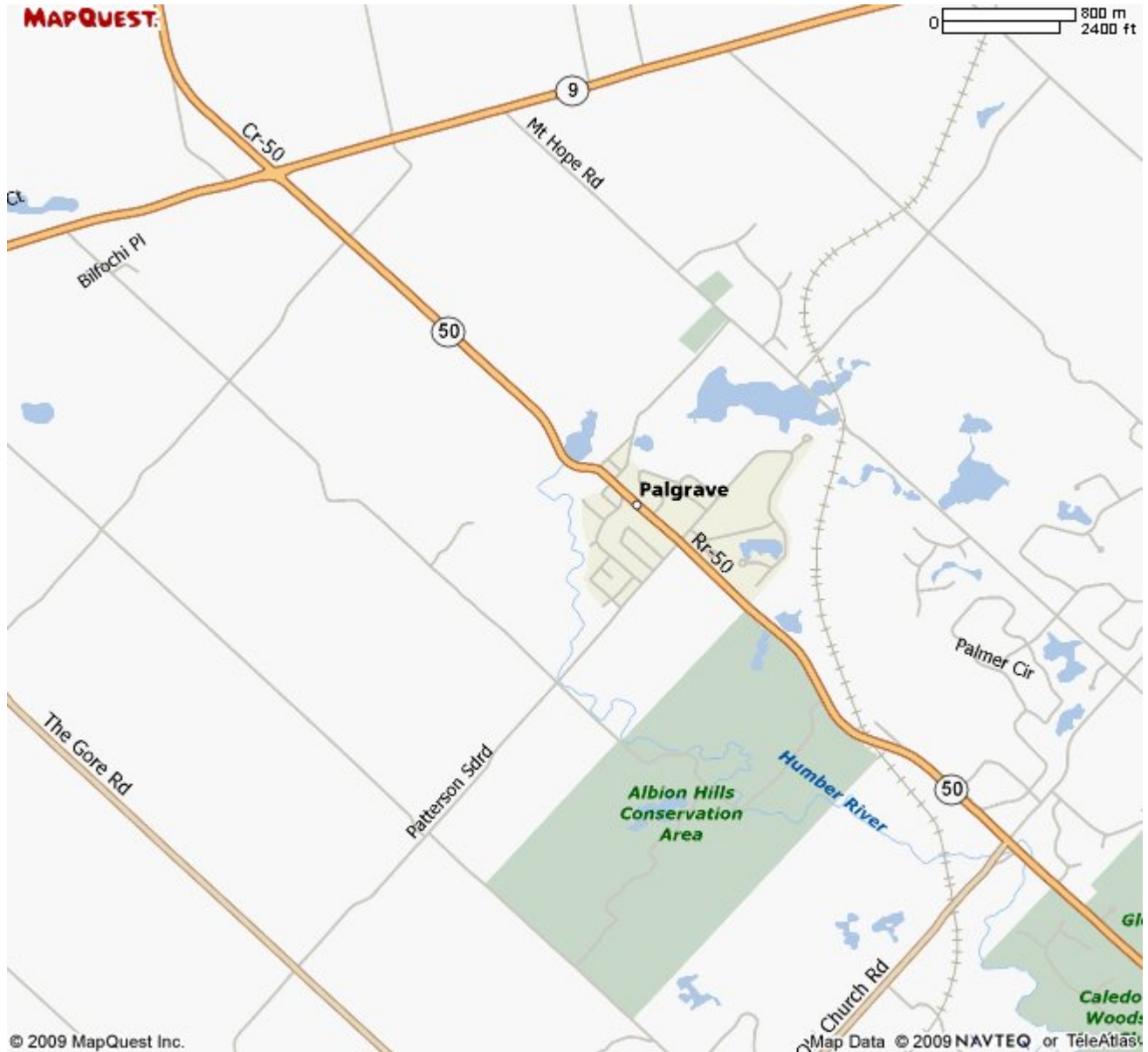
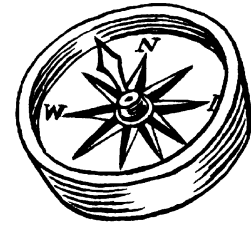
Important Stuff:

- Camp set-up (tents and shelters only) will be after 6 pm on Friday evening and your site is to be taken down and inspected by noon on Sunday. Parking will be very tight so if possible car pooling is recommended. Also, please note that absolutely NO vehicles will be allowed on the grass. You will be asked to unload at the side and then move your vehicle out of the way so others can also unload..
- Each group will be responsible for having the appropriate forms with them at camp – we will not be asking you to hand them in. You should have a copy of this year's registration form for ALL members in camp. All parent volunteers should complete and bring a copy of the Physical Fitness Form for non registered attendees. A copy of the completed Outdoor Activity Form approved by your group commissioner should also be available.
- First Aid will be available all weekend through our Medical Venturers.
- Please check your copy of B P&P and the Outdoor guide for the camping rules for Beavers. Available at www.scouts.ca
- Uniforms need only be worn for Opening, Closing and Scouts Own but neckers should be worn throughout the weekend. This is especially important for Beaver age as trying to find 'Hawkeye' or 'Rainbow' in all those people could be tough but visible neckers will help us return them to the right group.
- Pre-registrations are needed for day-only and groups camping over, no later than Sunday April 26, 2009. A follow up email closer to the date with more accurate numbers would be very much appreciated.
- There will be a meeting on Friday night at 9 pm at Headquarters, please send one registered leader from your group to attend.
- Please ensure that you have 1 fire extinguisher for every flame source and that your fire area is marked off. Also ensure you have water and a shovel in your fire area.
- Each group should bring one activity that works with our theme. Have fun with it and let's be creative. Rotation details will be provided later
- We are planning a demonstration by the Tottenham Falconry Centre for Sunday morning. Details on final schedule will be available closer to the camp.
- Crest designs are not required this year as we will be pre-ordering our crests in the hope that we will have them ready at the camp
- Everyone is encouraged to wear costumes. Please ensure that youth and leaders wear their neckers at all times. Get creative and make it part of your look!
- Potable water will be available.
- Picnic tables will be available.
- No Fire Barrels allowed – a shared campfire site will be available. Firewood must be purchased at camp and can not be brought in.
- No Dogs, except working dogs.
- Please ensure parents know that absolutely NO alcohol will be allowed.

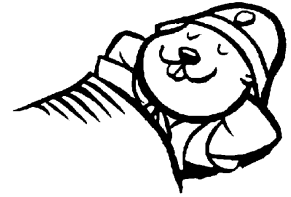
