

**SLS Cub Winterfest**

**Location:** The Pefferlaw Community Center is located at 38 Pete's Lane in Pefferlaw.  
**Registration 12pm Saturday – departure 11pm Sunday**

**Cost:** \$12.50 for youth and leaders (Cub Youth and Leaders)

**Food:** Hot Chocolate, soup, coffee and juice will be available all day. Packs sleeping over will be provided with Saturday dinner, Mug up, Sunday breakfast and snacks. Please advise of any food allergies with your registration.

**Activities:** Committee will be providing some activities for the event but each Pack is to bring an outdoor activity that can be done on a rotational basis. Please ensure that the activity can be completed within the allotted 15 minute rotation.

This year's theme is: ***Trek to the Poles***

**Crests:** Groups will receive one crest for each youth and leader registered as well as one for the flag. Crests will be ordered after Winterfest. Crest designs, hand drawn by the youth, may be submitted using the attached design sheet and must be handed in no later than February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2009 at Red Arrow (see attached design sheet).

**Campfire:** All packs are being asked to come prepared with a song, skit and cheer. Please let us know what you plan when you register. Due to time restrictions not all will be used.

**Extra Stuff:**

**Indoor shoes are mandatory. For safety reasons all outdoor shoes are to be removed before entering the Hall. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Dress for the weather and bring extra socks and mitts or gloves. Those attending for only the day should have at least 3 extra pairs of socks, while those staying overnight should bring at least 6 extra pairs.

Nobody is permitted on the stage at any time during the event.

No dogs with the exception of working dogs

Be responsible for your youth. Ensure your Leaders are watching your youth. Have all your forms and health cards. Meet your ratios. Ensure there are no youth tree climbing or damaging trees or property. All your youth should be in visual range at all times.

Make sure all youth and leaders are in uniform for opening, closing, and Scouts Own.

Please bring a shovel for each youth. These, as well as any personal belongings should be clearly labeled so they can be returned to their owners if misplaced. Bring appropriate overnight gear for indoor winter camp sleepover.

# Crest Design

This year we are again asking for your help in designing the crest for **Winterfest**. We know that we have some pretty talented youth in our area, so please help us out. We ask that all the crest designs be submitted on or before February Red Arrow (Sunday February 22, 2009).

Please use the following guidelines when designing your crest:

1. All designs are to be hand drawn by any youth registered in Beavers or Cubs.
2. Make sure their name and group are on back of the sheet.
3. Maximum of 5 colours not including background.
4. Designs to be submitted actual size from one of the 2 patterns provided.
5. Crests should reflect the theme of **Winterfest** (Trek to the Poles), and identify the event as South Lake Simcoe, **Winterfest 2009**.
