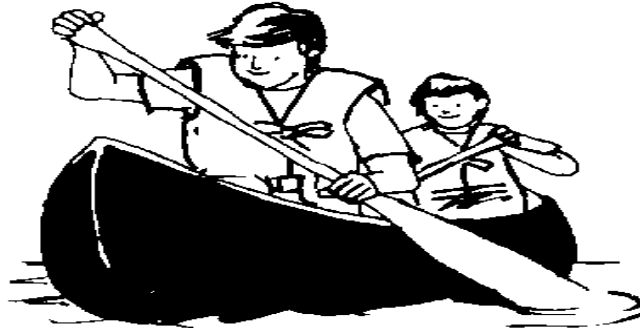




# Scouts Canada South Lake Simcoe Area



## Paddle Making

*If you have ever wanted to make your own paddle, then here is your opportunity.*

Session cost:       \$80 for a Basswood paddle  
                          \$100 for a Cherry paddle

Session location:   Camp just north of Bradford.  
                          You may camp here for the weekend if you wish or commute each day  
                          (You will need to be self-contained for food, water and shelter)
