

# ALGONQUIN CUB CAMP

## AUGUST 9-13<sup>TH</sup>, 2010

Welcome to the first camp for cubs at Algonquin. We are planning five days of fun and camp experience for your youth. Some of the activities that we are planning are introductory canoeing on Whitefish Lake, hiking the trails of Algonquin, leather craft from Tandy Leather, meeting an Algonquin Native and learning a little of their rich culture, meeting local artisans and of course checking out the wild life. The drop off will be on Monday morning approximately 8:00 a.m. and pick up will be approximately 5:00 p.m. on Friday at the 404 plaza in Newmarket.

We are asking that the youth have one year of experience in Cubs and that they have attended at least one Cub Camp.

The cost of the five day camp is \$200.00 and includes bus transportation, food, programme and a crest.

This camp is open to all qualifying youth; your leaders are not required to attend with you. We will have a liaison in Newmarket in case of emergency or for updated information on when the bus will arrive back in town.

Please note: Due to the distance to the nearest hospital, we are limiting attendance at this camp to those youth who do not require an epi pen for their allergies. If you arrive at the bus with an epi pen, your child WILL NOT be allowed to board.

We will be holding a Parent/Youth meeting in late June where all questions will be answered and all updated information including bus pick up and drop off will be given.
