## Outline

	<b>Session</b>	<b>Description</b>
1	Camp cooking I	Covers cooking in the outdoors, nutritious meals & snacks, recipes ideas, cooking in the various seasons
2	Camp cooking II	Learn various cooking techniques using various types of stoves, hobo stoves, reflector ovens, box ovens, over a fire, etc.
3	Camp set-up	From safe camp layout to setting up tents, dealing with weather and the seasons, four-legged visitors, waste disposal
4	Camp tools I	Proper care, safety and use of knives, axes & saws, maintenance and repairs
5	Camp tools II	Proper care, safety and use of stoves & lanterns, maintenance and repairs
6	Fire	Making fire starters, fire safety, building different types of fires, cooking over the fire
7	Hiking	An overview of hiking skills, day and night hikes, hikes with a purpose, gear, tracking, plant & animal identification
8	Knot tying - basic	Covers types and care of rope, basic knots and their uses, lots of practice
9	Knot tying - advanced	Advanced knot tying and techniques, decorative knots, activities with knots
10	Map & compass	Reading topographical maps, using a compass with a map, magnetic declination, estimating travel time
11	Mobile camp	Planning for multi-day mobile camps, food, gear, lightweight travel, safety
12	Navigation/Compass	Navigation with and without a compass, parts of the compass, taking bearings, following bearings, pacing distances
13	Orienteering	Equipment, control points, techniques, following & putting together an orienteering course
14	Pioneering - basic	Types of lashings and their uses, practice lashing, making camp gadgets
15	Pioneering advanced	- Learn how to construct advanced pioneering projects
16	Shelters	Types and use of shelters, materials, construction, throughout the seasons
