Paddle Making

Ever wanted to make your own paddle?

We will be running a paddle making session for Leaders and mature youth. At the end of the session, you will have crafted a paddle ready to be water-proofed and varnished (instructions will be provided). For most of the project, you will be using simple hand tools to shape your paddle.

 \$90 for a Maple paddle
 \$100 for a Cherry paddle

 You do need to be able to attend both Friday evening and Saturday all day
