Also, because the Conservation area is technically closed, we will need to take out with us all garbage, recycling, etc.. there will be one available to go in behind us, and make sure it is clean, so it will be our responsibility to clean up after ourselves

Sunday morning will be dedicated to Scouts Own and a "Sixers Council", to which all youth will need to attend. If one Leader can plan to join us, It would be appreciated. Camp will close at 12 noon Sunday.

This Camp will help all the older youth develop within the Pack, and will give them the tools to assist the Leaders. We will require some assistance with our program, so if there is anyone who would be willing to step up, and give the youth some direction, it would be appreciated.
